

Looking for a project with a lot of impact? Baby and Homeless Kits are projects for individuals or groups of any age (families, service clubs, scouts, youth groups, church groups, etc.) that will help those in our local community.



Baby Kit:

To assemble a Baby Care Kit you will need:

- 20 diapers (all one size)
 - wipes
 - baby shampoo
 - powder
 - one can formula
 - 12 jars of baby food
 - 2 plastic bags
 - 1 large paper bag
1. Place diapers in plastic bag and mark the outside of bag with the size and brand (to help with sensitivities to particular brands) of the diapers.
 2. Do the same thing with the baby food mark the stage on the outside of the bag
 3. Put all remaining items in a brown paper bag then add diapers and baby food.

We encourage you to add a card with personal message or prayer on it.

Homeless Kit:

To assemble a Homeless Kit you will need:

- One pair socks
- soap
- toothbrush
- toothpaste
- washcloth or hand towel
- deodorant
- comb
- shampoo
- Small blanket

Once you've gathered the necessary items, it's time to organize your hygiene kits. Group the items by product to make a simple assembly line. Put the hygiene items in a Ziploc bag so that they are easily accessible. Be sure that the caps are tight to prevent spilling when the hygiene kits are moved. Tie blanket with ribbon or string to Ziploc bag.

We encourage you to add a card with personal message or prayer on it.
